



Wetland and Wildlife Scientists/Permitting Specialists

Primary responsibilities would include performing wetland delineations, preparing permit applications (local, state, and federal), conducting wildlife and botanical surveys, rare, threatened and endangered species investigations, client management, interaction with State and Federal regulatory and resource agencies, data analysis/evaluation, report preparation, preparation for and presentation at public meetings, and business development activities, including the preparation of proposals for electric, transmission, gas pipeline, DOT and other linear energy projects. Travel is required.

Applicants should have a minimum of a Master's degree in wetland science, botany, soil science, wildlife biology, environmental science, ecology or a related field along with wetland scientist certification and/or certification as a Professional Wetland Scientist (PWS) through the Society of Wetland Scientists or soil scientist certification. Prior experience conducting wetlands delineation, permitting, botanical and endangered plant surveys in the northeast US is required. Strong writing and verbal communication skills are important, along with a high degree of comfort with computers and technology, a willingness to learn new skills, and flexibility in work assignments. Experience with completing applications and filings for federal and state regulatory agencies, including siting boards, is highly desirable. Candidates must be able to work in the United States without company sponsorship.
